Dear Parents and Guardians

Further to my message last week, I am writing to provide you with updated advice about the Novel Coronavirus outbreak relating to people arriving in Australia from mainland China.

Any child returning from mainland China (not including Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan) who was in mainland China on or after 1 February 2020 is to be isolated at home and should not attend school until 14 days after they were last in mainland China.

This recommendation applies only to children who were in mainland China on or after 1 **February 2020**. It does not apply to students who left mainland China before 1 February 2020.

As previously advised, parents of students who have been exposed to a confirmed Coronavirus case, or who have arrived in Australia from Hubei Province, should ensure that their child is isolated at home and does not attend school for 14 days.
